

All is not well with INDIA alliance: Omar

Srinagar: Amid a tussle between the Congress and Samajwadi Party over seat sharing for the Madhya Pradesh Assembly polls, National Conference leader Omar Abdullah on Monday said the situation within the opposition INDIA alliance was not good.

"All is not well with INDIA alliance. Some internal squabbles, which should not have been there, can be seen, especially in the four five states where elections are being held. We have seen how the Samajwadi Party and Congress are fighting each other. Both are saying that they will contest all the seats in UP. This is not good for INDIA alliance. Maybe after these state elections, we will meet again and will try to work together," Abdullah told reporters in north Kashmir's Kupwara district.

Asked about People's Alliance for Gupkar Declaration (PAGD) constituents hitting out at each other, Abdullah said he has not uttered a word against anyone.

"I have not said anything. I have not targeted any of my friends, despite the fact that for the past several months we have been targeted. But this is also right that for the first time I have not tried to stop my colleague," he said.

In an apparent reference to PDP leaders' criticising the National Conference at a party event last week, Abdullah said there was plenty his party can talk about if it were about raking up the past.

"We have plenty to talk about. They have been raking up issues for the past 30 years... we do not have to go that far, we just have to go back three or four years," he added.

Asked about BJP's claims that the situation in Kashmir was normal, the former chief minister asked why elections were not being held in Jammu and Kashmir if the situation is normal.

"If the situation is normal, why are elections not held? What is the excuse? Only yesterday, a police officer was shot at in broad daylight in Srinagar. Now, we heard that something has happened in Pulwama."

"In Rajouri, an area which we had cleared of militancy, every week or 10 days an incident or encounter takes place there. If this is normal situation, then be it," he said.

When asked about J-K elections, Abdullah said people are eagerly waiting for assembly elections.

"But there is no indication of these elections being held any time soon. Parliamentary elections are a compulsion for them but whether they will hold these or not, perhaps only two persons in the country know this and they have not spoken to me about it," he added.

BRS MP Prabhakar Reddy stabbed in election rally

Attack On Candidate An Attack On Me: KCR

Hyderabad: BRS assembly election candidate Kotha Prabhakar Reddy was on Monday stabbed while he was campaigning in Siddipet district by a 38-year-old man, police said.

The accused, identified as Raju, was taken into custody following the incident and a case was registered against him on the charge of attempt to murder, they said.

Prabhakar Reddy, who is an MP from Medak Lok Sabha constituency, suffered injuries in his stomach and was shifted to a hospital in Hyderabad after initially being rushed to a hospital in Gajwel of Siddipet district. His condition is said to be stable, police said.

The accused who came to meet the MP went close to him and attacked him with a knife, Siddipet Commissioner of Police NSwetha said.

Some party workers immediately caught hold of the accused and handed him over to the police.

The incident took place in Surampalli of Doulthabad mandal when Prabhakar Reddy, who has been fielded by BRS from Dubbak for the November 30 assembly elections, was campaigning, police said.

Reacting to the incident, Chief Minister K Chandrasekhar Rao said at a rally in Banswada that everyone should unequivocally condemn the attack on the candidate.

"I am saying the attack on our Dubbak candidate is an attack on me," he said.

"If the attacks are not stopped,

if there is no self control, we also have courage. If we also resort to the same acts, you will not remain. Even (your) dust also will not remain," he further said.

He appealed to the people of Telangana and intellectuals to condemn violence in politics.

Telangana Governor Tamilisai Soundararajan expressed shock over the incident and directed the state Director General of Police to take stringent measures to investigate the incident and ensure the safety of contesting candidates and campaigners during the election period.

"I am shocked to learn about the attack on Medak MP and BRS Dubbak MLA candidate Kotha Prabhakar Reddy during an election campaign in Surampalli of Doulthabad mandal. Violence has no place in democracy, and such incidents are a threat to the democratic process," Soundararajan, was quoted as saying in a press communique issued by Raj Bhavan.

It is essential to maintain a peaceful and secure environment for free and fair elections, the Governor said and wished the MP a speedy recovery.

Meanwhile, Telangana Health and Finance Minister T Harish Rao strongly condemned the incident and said the government has taken serious note of it.

"A thorough inquiry shall be conducted to probe if there is any political conspiracy in the attempt to murder Prabhakar Reddy," Harish Rao said.

TV footage showed Prabhakar Reddy pressing the stab wound on his stomach (to stop the bleeding) while sitting in a vehicle.

Vijayan, Union MoS trade verbal blows over Hamas

Kochi: Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan and Union Minister of State (MoS) Rajeev Chandrasekhar traded verbal blows on Monday with the BJP leader calling the CM a "liar" and he in turn lashing out by terming the minister "extremely venomous".

The verbal duel between the two followed CM's severe criticism of a post by Chandrasekhar on social media platform X in which the union minister seemed to place blame on a particular community for the multiple blasts on Sunday at a Christian gathering near Kochi that killed three persons and injured over 50.

On Sunday after reports of the blasts came out, Chandrasekhar had posted on X - "Dirty shameless appeasement politics by a discredited CM (and HM) @pinarayivijayan besieged by corruption charges. Sitting in Delhi and protesting against Israel, when in Kerala open calls by Terrorist Hamas for Jihad is causing attacks and bomb blasts on innocent Christians."

Criticising Chandrasekhar's post, Vijayan at a press conference in the evening said that the statements by the BJP leader were a reflection of his "absolute communal outlook".

Hitting back at the CM for his remarks, Chandrasekhar on Monday accused Vijayan of being a "liar" and using terms like 'communal' and 'communalism' to "hide his ineptness as Home Minister of the state" and "cover up his own and his government's corruption and appeasement politics that he has copied from the Congress."

Speaking to reporters in Kochi on Monday afternoon, he further alleged that Kerala under Vijayan has shown tolerance towards radical elements and radicalisation.

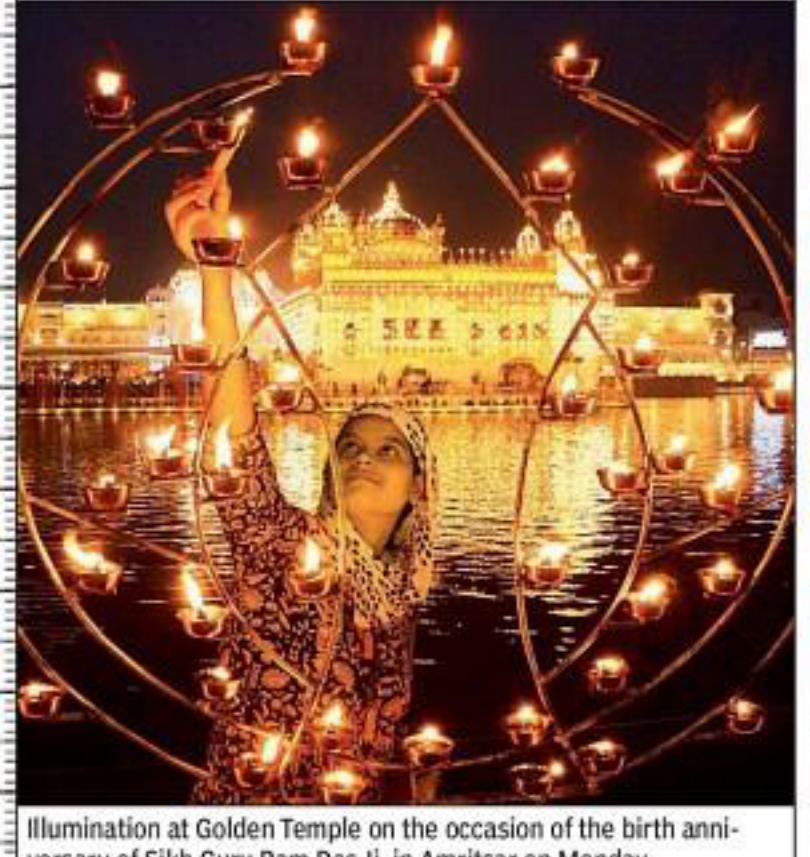
Chandrasekhar said he did not mention any community in his post on X, and sought to turn the attack back against the CM for calling him communal, saying, "I had talked about Hamas and it was almost like the CM was trying to equate Hamas with the broader Muslim brothers and sisters of our state and country." He further alleged that both the Congress and the Left in Kerala have a history of appeasement of radical elements in the state.

Chandrasekhar also said that he has no faith in the political leadership that "manipulated" Kerala Police.

"I am the last person you can call communal. I have much deeper relationships with the various communities than Pinarayi Vijayan could ever have," he claimed.

Later in the day at a press conference held at the Cochin International Airport Ltd (CIAL) here, Vijayan said that Chandrasekhar's remarks are indicative of his particular mindset.

Futuristic tech needed to speed growth: Gadkari

Guwahati: Union minister Nitin Gadkari on Monday stressed on futuristic technology across all sectors for ensuring the country's accelerated growth, emphasising on the role of students in achieving the goal.

He also maintained that research has to be result-oriented with proper analysis of the market before venturing into any project.

He was speaking at a special convocation of Assam down town University here, where the union road transport and highways minister was conferred with an honorary D. Litt. Degree in recognition of his contribution to the infrastructure development of the North East region.

"The prime minister has envisioned a five trillion dollar economy and an 'Atma Nirbhar Bharat'. These can be possible only by implementing futuristic technology, where students can contribute to make the country a super economic power," Gadkari said. He emphasised on research which ensures that products have value-addition and multiple benefits for the economic sector in diverse ways.

The union minister said that before carrying out research, the focus should be on proven technology, economic viability, availability of raw materials and marketability of finished products.

The minister also visited the Kamakhya temple and paid obeisance before the Goddess atop Nilachal Hill in the city.

Remove plaques without Tagore's name: Mamata

Kolkata: West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Monday demanded the removal of the "insulting plaques" which omit the name of Rabindranath Tagore from Visva Bharati's stone tablets commemorating UNESCO's award of World Heritage Site to the Santiniketan-based university.

She said the current plaques were an "arrogant display of self-absorbed narcissism". Plaques put up by Visva Bharati last week have the names of Prime Minister Narendra Modi as chancellor of the university and vice-chancellor Prof Bidyut Chakraborty. Since Friday, TMC party workers have been protesting demanding removal of the plaques.

3 thugs arrested

Noida: Three thugs who allegedly duped small firms and NGOs have been arrested by the police in Greater Noida and fake currency notes of value Rs 8.30 crore have been seized, officials said on Monday.

The accused, were going to Lucknow on Sunday. They were arrested during a patrol duty, Additional DCP (Greater Noida) Ashok Kumar said.

"Two of the accused first intercepted by the police near Salarpur underpass. When all three were taken into custody, they admitted to being part of a gang that used fake currency notes to dupe small companies and non government organisations," Kumar said.

During the investigation, they also revealed that their kingpin is based in Lucknow and police teams are already working to arrest him, the additional DCP said. Those arrested were identified as Vishal Chauhan of Delhi, Mobin Khan of Shahjahanpur and Upendra Singh from Agra.
